Dear Parents/Guardians,

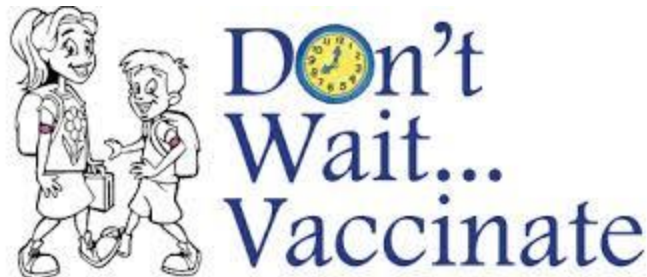

Parents of 12th Grade Students

If you have not already, your young adult must have
Meningococcal Booster Vaccine



All incoming seniors need to have their meningococcal booster prior to the start of their senior year (the second dose is *not* required for students who received dose 1 on or after their 16th birthday). Bring documentation of shot given to the School Clinic.

- Meningitis is caused by bacteria that can be spread through the exchange of respiratory and throat secretions (e.g. saliva or mucus), sharing drinks, kissing, close contact. Commonly spread amongst young adults on campus. <http://www.cdc.gov/meningitis/bacterial.html>
- Remember to wash hands, cover coughs; do not share drinks and vaccinate.
- Vaccination records not submitted this school year should be brought to registration in August.

Many things are changing this school year, but one thing that is not, is immunization requirements. To help families prepare for the new school year,

Super Shot is giving away backpacks to the first 1,000 students that:

- ✓ Schedule an appointment.
- ✓ Mention the "Have Your Back" promotion.
- ✓ Receive all required back-to-school immunizations at Super Shot.

Super Shot is seeing patients by appointment only, requiring face masks, limiting one parent to one child being vaccinated, checking the temperature of everyone coming in the door, moving families to a cleaned exam room as soon as they check in, and limiting the time in the facility through expedited paperwork.

- Super Shot is **located at 1515 Hobson Rd, Fort Wayne, IN.**
- Most commercial insurance plans, Medicaid, uninsured and underinsured children are accepted.
- Daytime, evening, and weekend appointments available.
- Call **260-424-7468 (SHOT)** to make an appointment and mention the "Have Your Back" promotion to receive a free backpack.
- **Walk-in patients not eligible** for the "Have Your Back" promotion due to social distancing procedures.
- One backpack per child.



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
